

OEM FOTA Compliance Reporting Instructions

The OD FOTA-OEM Compliance Report document is the master document, and can reference other supporting documentation. Examples of supporting documentation may include:

- For an OEM using the VZ-FOTA solution (motive), refer to 'VZ-Nokia OD High Level On-boarding & Self-testing' process Doc
 - ✓ Contact your Module vendor to understand software update availability
 - ✓ Perform Self-test using Motive Bridge
 - ✓ Provide logs and any other supporting info (e.g. screenshots) from device showing the Nokia(Motive) FOTA self-testing results
- For an OEM using a 3rd party, non-Verizon Firmware-Over-the-Air (FOTA) solution to support devices' firmware updates, the OEM must provide documentation on the solution and test results demonstrating a successful device update during Open Development (OD) device certification.
 - ✓ Documentation describing a 3rd party or a proprietary FOTA solution
 - ✓ Additional system architecture documentation

The OEM must complete all the sections in the OD FOTA-OEM Compliance Report document.

- ✓ Logs and/or screenshots of a device going through a FOTA upgrade, clearly indicating the software versions before and after the FOTA update.

All documentation and supporting logs/screenshots must be stored in a single ZIP file, and uploaded to the Verizon Open Development. The final ZIP file to be uploaded will contain the completed OD FOTA-OEM Compliance Report, any additional support documentation, and the logs and/or screenshots.
