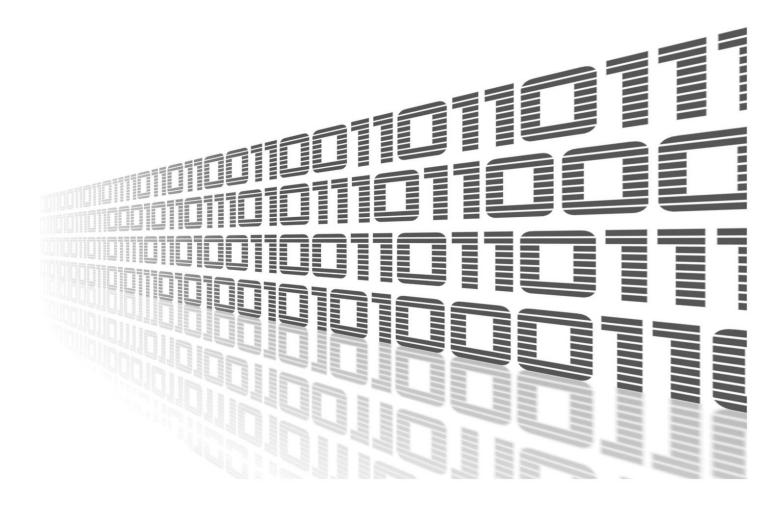

1. Changelog

1.1 Customer Logo Changelog



2. Customer Logo Router App

Customer Logo router app allows to change the router's logo in web interface.



This router app is intended only for Advantech industrial routers manufactured with FW 6.2.0 or later and is not supported by routers of v2 platform.

3. Web Interace

For configuration of the *Customer Logo* router app a web interface is available. It can be invoked by pressing the module name on the *Router apps* page of the router's web interface.




Figure 1: Router app menu

Left part of the Customer Logo module web interface contains menu with section *Configuration* and section *Customization*, see the figure 1. *Configuration* section contains only the *Logo* item and *Customization* section contains only the *Return* item that switches the module's web interface back to the main interface of the router.

3.1 Configuration

To set your own logo into the web interface, use the *Choose File* button, select the logo file (maximum size of 10 kB) and click on the *Update* button. Use the *Return* button to return to the router's web interface.

Use Shift + F5 to reload your current page (this will update your browser's cache).

3.2 Insert your own logo into the installation file

This modification of the installation file allows you to install the UM Customer Logo with your logo in the future.

3.2.1 How to generate your own UM Customer Logo

- Insert your logo into the web interface as described above.
- Open a command line or other terminal application on your computer, enter the following command ssh root@192.168.1.1
 - (if you have changed the local IP address of your router please update the command accordingly) and press Enter.
- The program will ask you for the root password. Type it and press Enter.
- Paste the script according to the version of your router (described below).
- Download the updated version of the UM Customer Logo installation file. Links for modified module are described below.

Script for v2i routers:

```
cp -r /opt/customerlogo /tmp/customerlogo
rm -f /tmp/customerlogo/etc/logo.png
mv /tmp/customerlogo/etc/settings /tmp/customerlogo/etc/defaults
cd /tmp
tar -czvf customerlogo.v2.tgz customerlogo/
ln -s /tmp/customerlogo.v2.tgz /opt/customerlogo/www/customerlogo.v2.tgz
```

Script for v3 routers:

```
cp -r /opt/customerlogo /tmp/customerlogo
rm -f /tmp/customerlogo/etc/logo.png
mv /tmp/customerlogo/etc/settings /tmp/customerlogo/etc/defaults
cd /tmp
tar -czvf customerlogo.v3.tgz customerlogo/
ln -s /tmp/customerlogo.v3.tgz /opt/customerlogo/www/customerlogo.v3.tgz
```
