2. Description of the module



Router app *Lua* is not contained in the standard router firmware. Uploading of this router app is described in the Configuration manual (see Chapter [Related Documents](#)).

Lua supports scripting language that combines simple procedural syntax with powerful data description constructs based on associative arrays and extensible semantics.

3. Installation

Like every other Router App, the Lua is installed in *Router Apps* section in the router configuration page. Once the installation of the module is complete, the module is listed among other installed modules, but the module itself does not have any GUI, only includes information about licenses.

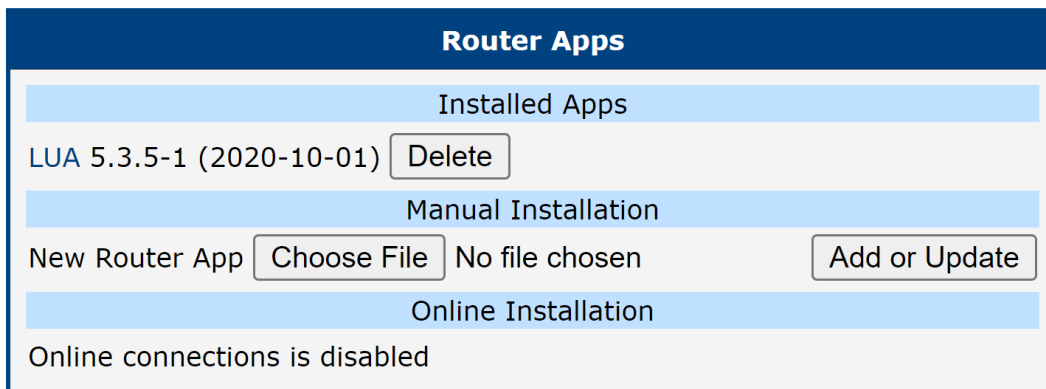


Figure 1: Router Apps
