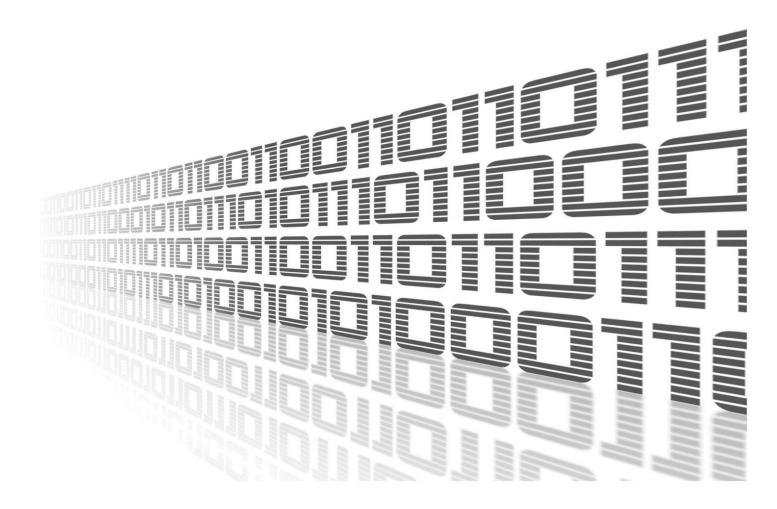

2. Description of the module



Router app *Service Access Limitation* is not contained in the standard router firmware. Uploading of this router app is described in the Configuration manual (see Chapter Related Documents).

Service Access Limitation is used for simple service access management. You're be able to limit access to a service per interface in it's GUI.

3. Installation

Like every other Router App, the Service Access Limitation is installed in *Router Apps* section in the router configuration page. Once the installation of the app is complete, the app is listed among other installed modules, it contains GUI with Status and Configuration section.




Figure 1: Router Apps

4.1 Status

This section showcases if the *Service Access Limitation* is currently operating. The status of router app is determined whether you *Enable/Disable rules* in the configuration section.

You can configurate which of your router's interfaces will be operating with each service chosen by you.




Figure 3: Configuration
